PETITION 0 N RCMP WRONGDOING

At its meeting on July 25, 1978 the CUASA Steering Committee passed a motion supporting the objectives of a Canadian Civil Liberties Association petition on RCMP law breaking.

The petition requests "the Federal Government immediately to invoke, as follows, the normal processes of law enforcement.

- Initiate investigations, prosecutions, and disciplinary proceedings within its jurisdiction in such matters as mail openings and alleged RCMP misleading of Federal Cabinet Ministers.
- Transmit to the Provincial Attorneys General whatever evidence falls within their jurisdiction in such matters as break-ins, theft, arson, etc."
