### CHANGES TO THE RETIREMENT PLAN ARE IMMINENT

As a result of unexpectedly favourable returns on investment, the Carleton University Retirement Plan has accumulated a surplus sufficient to fund improvements to the plan. The variety of possible improvements that are available to choose from is large. To ensure that the choice that is eventually made reflects the concerns of a majority of members, the Pension Committee will be circulating a questionnaire to all employees of the University.

Because of the long-term significance that this decision will have for us all, it is important that the responses to the questionnaire be as informed as possible. Accordingly, CUASA is holding an information meeting on the retirement plan and possible improvements to it. CUASA's representatives on the Pension Committee will be present to provide a general background and to answer any questions you may have.
