More Changes to Pay

The Dental and Extended Health Care contracts are being renewed with Blue Cross effective September 1, 1993 to August 31, 1994. Based on a positive experience rating the cost of both these contracts will decrease.

CUASA members currently pay \$12.70 per month for group life insurance. This amount will be reduced by \$8.11 per month (the savings from the benefit plans). Monthly payment will decline to \$4.59 for group life insurance. This change will be made in time for the August 30 paycheque.
