Article IX (1) and (4) **Change "mail" to electronic**  
Article XIV (2) **Constitutional amendments timeline**  
Article VII **Equity Committee and Chair of Nominations & Elections clause**

### **Narrowly failed:**

Article VI (2) Gender Rotation of the President –Elect
