NEW COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT RATIFIED

Last week's ratification vote produced the following results:

In favour	181	91.0
Against	18	9.0
(one spoiled ballot)	Total	199 100.0

The turnout ranged between 40 and 45 per cent of the membership, depending upon the estimate made for the number of members on sabbatical or other leaves.

An early Newsletter will include some comment on the implications of the ratification.

A new "red book", containing the full provisions of the new Collective Agreement, should be available in May. Meanwhile, if you have any questions, please consult the material circulated prior to ratification or contact your representative on the CUASA Council or the CUASA Office.
