SALES TAX REBATES FOR GRANT HOLDERS

After listening to a brief from OCUFA and the Faculty Association at University of Toronto at public hearings on the new Sales Tax provisions, the Provincial Government has agreed to make rebates for the sales tax charged on equipment purchased on research grants. A directive explaining the procedures will be issued shortly.

THE NEW COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT
