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## YOUR MAY PAYCHEQUE

Because the 1986-87 negotiated salary increase was on your May cheque, you may not have noticed that the cheque was slightly less than it should have been.

That's because, through a misunderstanding in Personnel, the employer paid only 31% of your OHIP premiums rather than the 35% agreed in the last round of bargaining. Next May the employer's contribution goes up to 50%, another result of our last round of collective bargaining.

When we caught the error in the last pay period, we contacted the Vice-President of planning and development who quickly moved to correct it.

There isn't a lot of money involved, unless it is calculated over a period of years. But there is an important principle involved. Our long-range aim, of course, is that the employer pay the entire OHIP premium. We'll be pursuing that goal in the next round of bargaining.

CUASA would also like to thank those members who took the time to check their paycheques and let us know that the agreed 35% was not reflected on the May cheque.
