DISAFFILIATION FROM OCUFA

CUASA conducted the ratification vote on disaffiliation from OCUFA over two weeks with two advanced polls. This resulted in the largest turnout since certification in 1975. 62.4% of those voting voted in favour of disaffiliating from OCUFA.

OCUFA has been notified of the result of the vote and has acknowledged the notification. The disaffiliation becomes effective July 1, 1994.
